How-To (quick reference)



1. Identify the delivery team's iteration goal

Gather the whole team so the plan can be built together.



Slice down any grand vision into a tiny first deliverable.



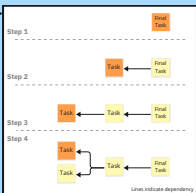
Build knowledge and validate the team understands the what and the why of this increment.



Identify what already exists today which can be built on.



2. Start with the ending, and end with the start

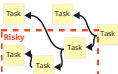


At the same time, use these techniques to keep the project plan healthy

Repeatedly break work down until there are only small tasks



Strategically de-risk parts of the project that could create problems



Put an airlock between delivery and technical innovation



4. Propose a transparent, realistic, and informed plan

Collect Project Plan Details



Identify workload consumed by other projects in progress



Consider external team dependencies



Calculate team's available time allocation



Express a simple project proposal based on details
